Start times

Start as early as 5:00am depending upon the particular Storm and the forecast. If the snow is blowing and Public Works gets behind one machine, they will also work nights.

Note: All times change upon depth of snow fall; some areas have more snow than the others; at times we have to see which areas are drifting---so the following routes are subject to change.

Plow Truck Route

1. FAA Road school bus route
2. Third Avenue hill
3. Young Rd, Skyline, & Highland Estates
4. Beach Road to cul-de-sac
5. Spruce Grove
6. Jones Road
7. Fairgrounds loop
8. Gruenning Road
9. Major Road
10. Mt. Riley
11. River Road & Chilkat Trails
12. Front Street to boat harbor
13. Helms Loop

Sand Truck Route

1. Starts at the Public Safety Bldg
2. Administration Building
3. Steep hills
4. School bus routes
5. Other places as operators call in
6. Senior Center & Senior Village
7. Chilkat Valley Preschool
8. Public Schools
9. Pool area
10. Visitor Center
11. Chilkat Center
12. All intersections and stop signs
13. Contracted roads, as needed
14. Lutak Dock, on call

Case Loader Route

1. Public Safety Building, Third Ave.
2. Port Chilkoot
3. Tower Road
4. Portage Street
5. Totem Street
6. Theater Street
7. Battle Road
8. New Hart Sub-Division
9. Water tank FAA & Tower Road
10. Myra Lane
11. Deishu Drive
12. Clean up Public Safety Building
13. Alleys in Port Chilkoot
14. On call for Beach Road if too much snow to get up hill

Blade and One Loader – Route

1. Second Avenue
2. Third Avenue
3. Fir Street
4. Mission Street
5. Willard Street
6. Senior Center
7. Dalton hill
8. Union hill
9. View hill
10. North Fir St & Ocean View
11. Young Road
12. Barnett Road
13. Oslund Street
14. Mathis Street
15. Lynnvue Drive
16. Fourth Avenue
17. View Street
18. Dalton Street
19. Fourth Avenue
20. Fifth Avenue
21. Sixth Avenue
22. Loader on call if snow too deep on Young Road
23. Human Resource Building
24. Loader picks up alleys when it catches the blade
25. Loader drops back to load sand truck when called
26. Loader on call to Piedad and Highland
27. Estates if water tank road has too much snow for plow truck
28. When blade catches up, it starts winging back snow with wing
29. Loaders plow out hydrants
30. Blade and loader on call to help on Port Chilkoot if loader gets behind

Second Day Tasks, if storm breaks

1. Clean berms
2. Hydrants
3. Intersections
4. Sidewalks
5. Pile snow at Public Safety Building
6. Clean snow and ice from catch basins
7. Push back snow and berms to make room for next snow
8. Grease and repair snow equipment
9. Re-sand if needed
10. If a machine breaks down others are sent to assist, if possible
11. If it's something that needs two men to fix, two plow machines are down until person is not needed
