Mary Core, Administrative Assistant, Redistricting Board confirmed the boundaries for Plan B, D, G, and the AFFER map after consultation with John Torgerson, Board Chair, via telephone June 25, 2013. I also worked through the maps with Board Member Peggy Ann McConnochie. She stated that she will seek clarification for Maps D and the AFFER map when she goes to Anchorage this Thursday. However, it is recommended that we examine the boundaries using our GIS program. Tracy Cui will return to the office on Monday, July 1, and could verify these boundaries prior to the July 2 public hearing.
