

# HAINES BOROUGH

## SNOW REMOVAL AND SANDING PRIORITIES



1. Public Safety Building (Fire, Police, Assembly Chambers)
2. Main Townsite Arterials and Business Streets
3. Streets to Highways
4. Residential Streets
5. Alleys
6. Snow Berms and Driveways
7. Public Parking Lots

**The main objective is to keep the townsite streets and roadways open for the safe passage of traffic.**

Private parking is not allowed on any borough townsite street. This protects your car from being plowed in or damaged during snow removal. Vehicles left parked in areas of snow removal will be towed and ticketed and the owner fined.



When all streets are open, borough equipment operators will return to try to clean up and remove driveway berms. Whenever possible, operators try to minimize the size of berms across driveways.

It is unlawful for any person to place snow from their private property onto any borough townsite right-of-way, including streets, sidewalks, ditches, and parking lots. If you are clearing snow from any area of your property, you must place it elsewhere on your own property or on other private property with the consent of the owner.



Please do not allow children to build tunnels or forts in snow berms at any time! Operators may not always be able to see small children and they may be injured.
